

How to Find the Arkansas Domestic Relations Laws Online

There are currently no Arkansas government websites that publish the Arkansas Domestic Relations laws online and allow direct linking to the information (if you know otherwise, please do [tell us](#)). However the arkleg.state.ar.us website does allow you to browse the Arkansas Marriage Code on their site. Here's how:

1) Go to 'arkleg.state.ar.us' (by clicking the link above) and then click 'Arkansas Code'.




